Purpose:

The Community Hubs Program aims to support migrant and refugee families (including children 0-6 years of age) by offering meaningful social activities as well as access to existing support services including local education, health, community and settlement services. The program offers families various opportunities to gain skills through formal and informal training, including English classes, breakfast clubs, homework clubs and community events.

English Practice Assistant will work alongside English Practice Facilitator/s and their Community Hub Leader to deliver creative English language support to parents, grandparents and other community members. The Hub English Conversation group aims to provide practical English language support for day-to-day communication through a focus on essential life activities such as shopping, making and re-scheduling appointments, initiating informal conversations with teachers, community services and in social settings.

Specific duties and responsibilities:

- Assist in room set up and pack up
- Assist Community Hub Leader to prepare work sheets and attendance sheets.
- Initiate ice breaker activities with participants
- Support participants to feel comfortable in practising their English in a group setting



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- Actively support SSI's vision and values
- Work in accordance with SSI policies and procedures
- Follow all reasonable directions provided by the English Practice Facilitator or Community Hub Leader
