## **Purpose:**

The Friendship Garden in Auburn offers newly arrived migrants, refugees and people seeking asylum access to a shared community space where people can connect with others, grow local and traditional food, and share and gain knowledge about gardening and permaculture.

The Friendship Garden Playgroup has been established, in partnership with Playgroup NSW, to support families, from Culturally and Linguistically Diverse (CALD) backgrounds who have pre-school aged children. Delivered in a structured playgroup setting, children engage in activities that promote social connection and creative expression, and help to develop their understanding of the environment. Playgroup Assistants help to connect participating families, prepare and serve food, set up and pack up resources, and provide language assistance.

### Specific duties and responsibilities:

- Support the facilitator to connect families with each other
- Support the facilitator with activities, such as water and Lego play, planting, arts & crafts
- Assist with organising and serving refreshments to participants
- Assist with set up and pack up of resources
- Support the facilitator with planning future playgroup activities
- Provide language support for clients in a relevant language (as required)
- Actively support SSI's vision and values
