

Can I get tickets at the gate?

This is a FREE family-friendly event. We kindly encourage you to book your free ticket for the event beforehand at https://events.humanitix.com/world-of-cultures-logan-23. We will be welcoming walk-ins on the day and monitoring capacity.

What should I bring?

Please note that there will be performances on the outdoor stage. We suggest bringing picnic rugs and beach/camping chairs for your comfort. The lawn will have designated 'picnic rug only' areas, and there will be space for chairs behind those areas.

Here's a checklist of what to bring:

- Picnic rug
- Beach/camping chair
- Water bottle
- Cozy jumper for the evening
- Raincoat in case of wet weather (indoor spaces will be open).

Can I fill up my water bottle at the event?

How do I get there and where do I park?

By car: Limited parking is available onsite so you will need to arrive early to secure a space. Alternatively, there is additional parking located at Logan Entertainment Centre (LEC) 170 Wembley Road, Logan Central.

FREE Shuttle Bus:

A shuttle bus for the event will run continuously from 3.30pm until the last departure at 9pm:

- Starting point: Logan Entertainment Centre Rear Carpark
- Pick-up point: Platform 2 at Logan Central Bus Station, Wembley Road (towards Kingston Road)
- Drop-off point: Kingston Butter Factory
- Return to Logan Entertainment Centre Rear Carpark

By train: KBF is located next to Kingston Train Station and is accessible via Beenleigh or Ferny Grove lines. Disembark at Kingston Station then take a 200m stroll from the station to KBF. The train station and the entire KBF Precinct are accessible for prams and mobility devices.

Is the venue accessible to people with disability?

- A relaxed area will be available for patrons to access at any time during the event.
