On Monday October 29 there will be a FREE Sydney Metropolis PhD Workshop Program at the UTS Business School.

This is open to any graduate student attending an Australian university. The program will include presentations from leading international and Australian immigration scholars, including Professor Dan Hiebert (Geography University of British Columbia, Canada) and Professor Pieter Bevelander, (Malmö Institute for Studies of Migration, Diversity and Welfare Malmö University, Sweden). Australian immigration scholars include Professor Jock Collins (UTS Business School) and Professor Alan Gamlen (Geography, Monash University). PhD students will also have the opportunity to present a five minute summary of their PhD topic to a panel.
