



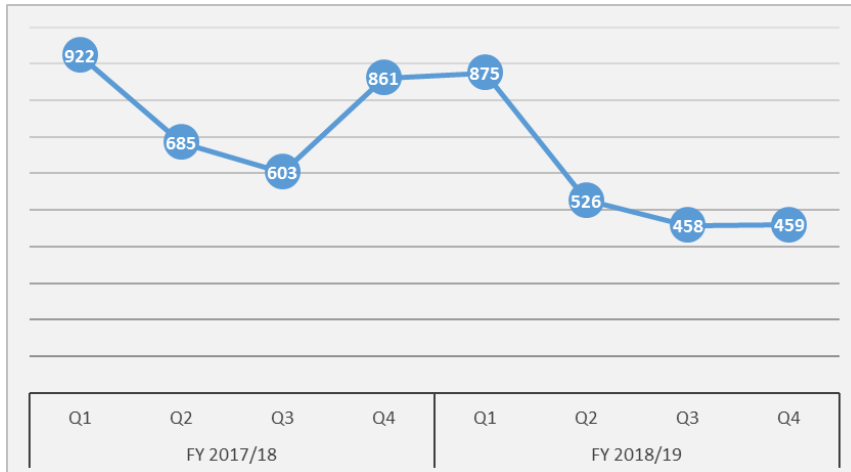

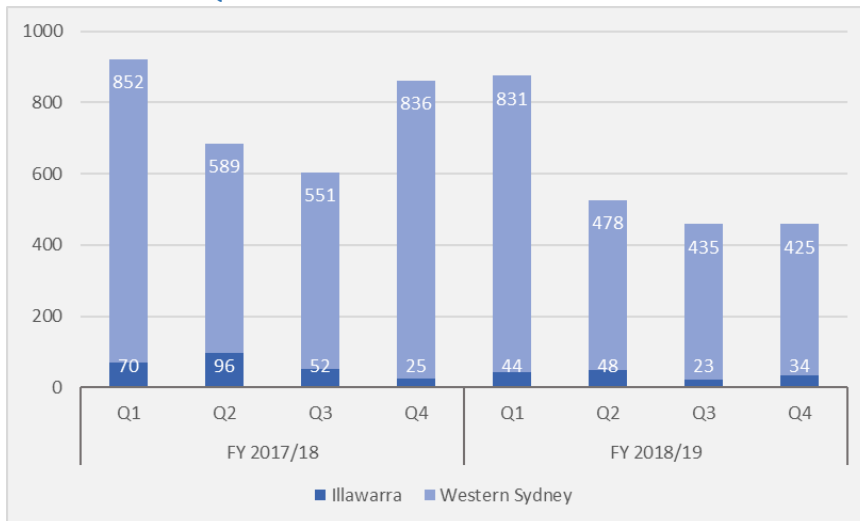
INTAKE (Financial Year 2017/18 and 2018/19)

NUMBER OF CLIENTS BY QUARTER



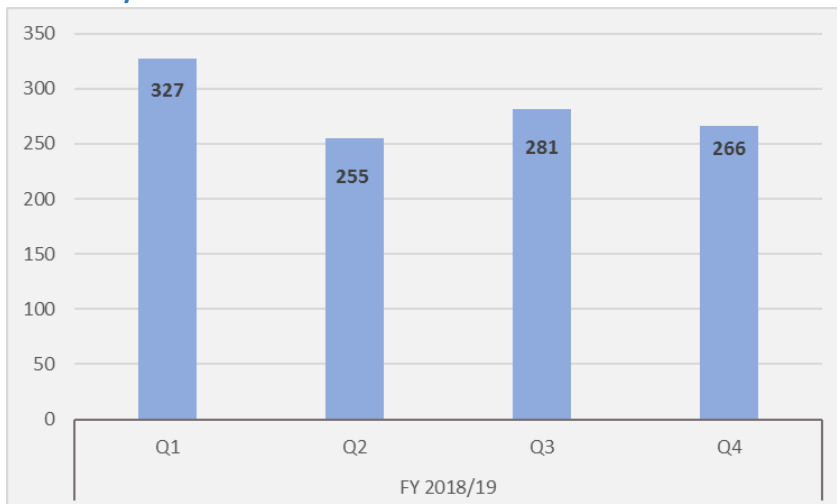
The RESP caseload stabilised in the second part of the financial year

CLIENT INTAKE BY QUARTER IN WESTERN SYDNEY AND ILLAWARRA REGIONS



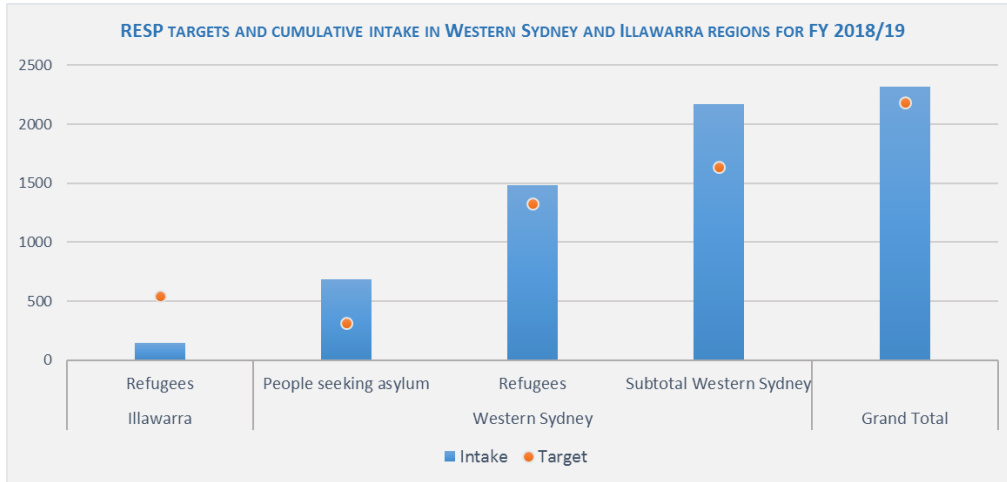
There was a slight increase in the intake in the Illawarra Region

CLIENT EXIT/DISENGAGEMENT IN WESTERN SYDNEY AND ILLAWARRA REGIONS

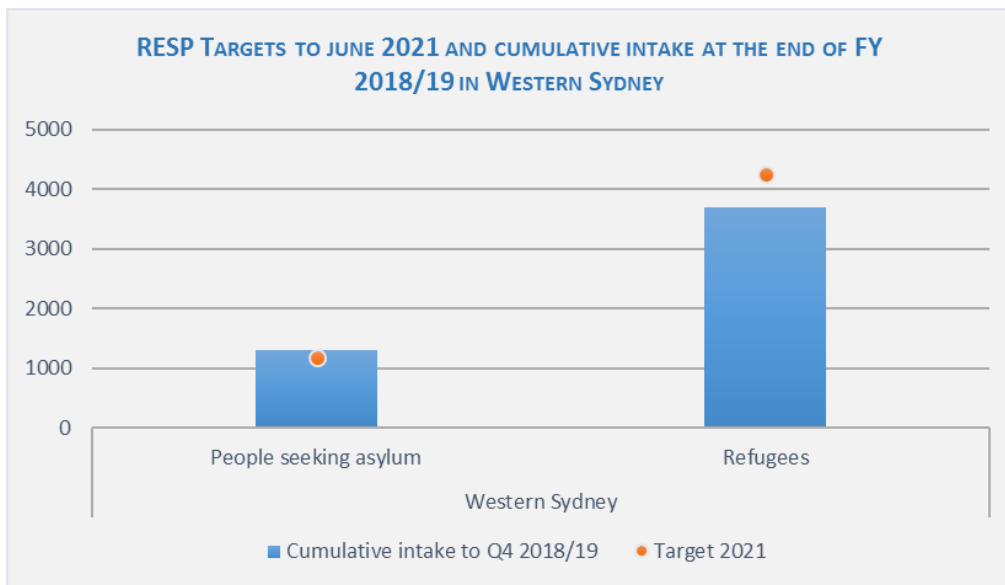


The number of clients exiting the program has stabilised since Q2 of FY 2018/19

PROGRAM TARGETS



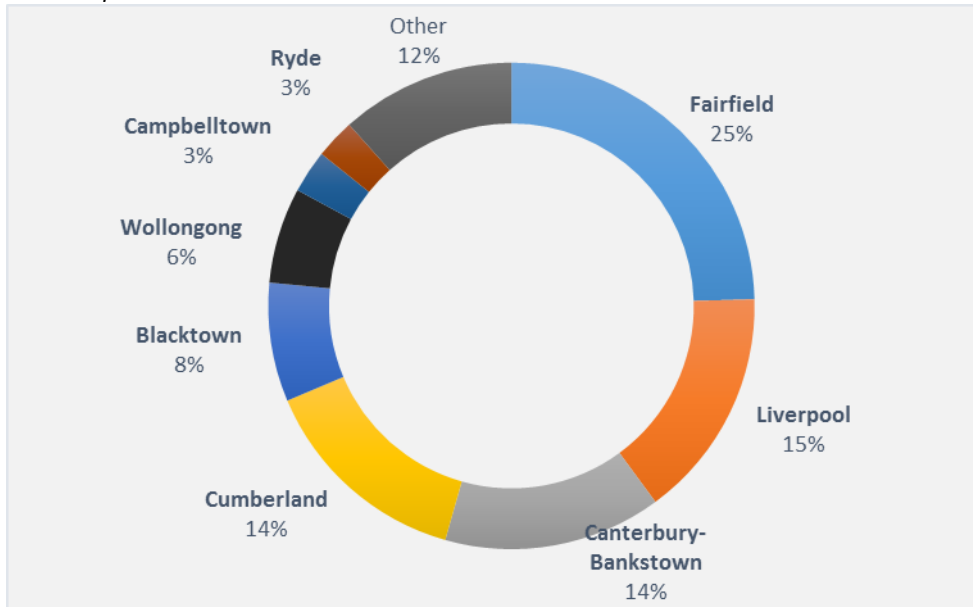
The targets for the current FY have been reached overall and in the Western Sydney Region. The caseload in the Illawarra Region fell short of the yearly target



The client intake target to 2021 in Western Sydney has already been met for people seeking asylum and is well on track for refugees

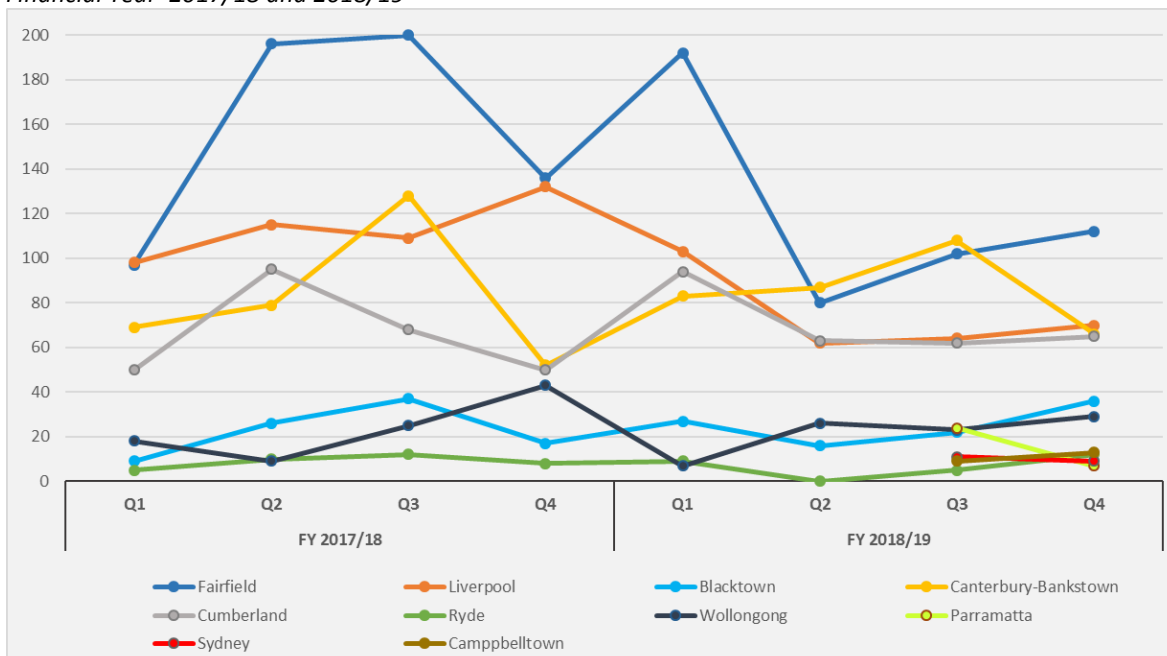
LOCATIONS

In the most recent quarter, more than half of the clients reside between Canterbury – Bankstown Liverpool and Fairfield

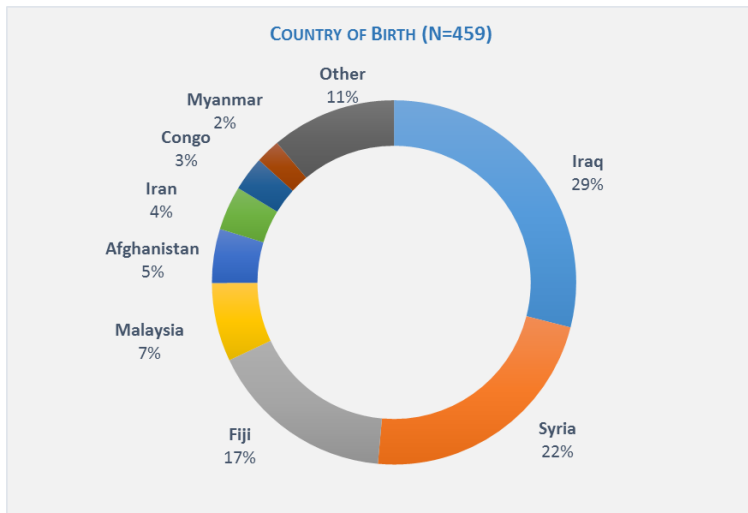
LGA OF CLIENT'S RESIDENCE BY QUARTER
 Financial Year 2017/18 and 2018/19



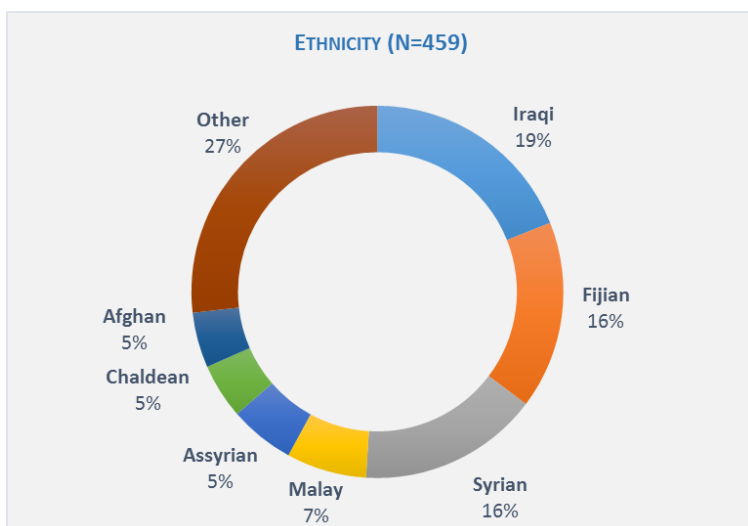
There are big fluctuations in client numbers especially in Fairfield and Canterbury – Bankstown

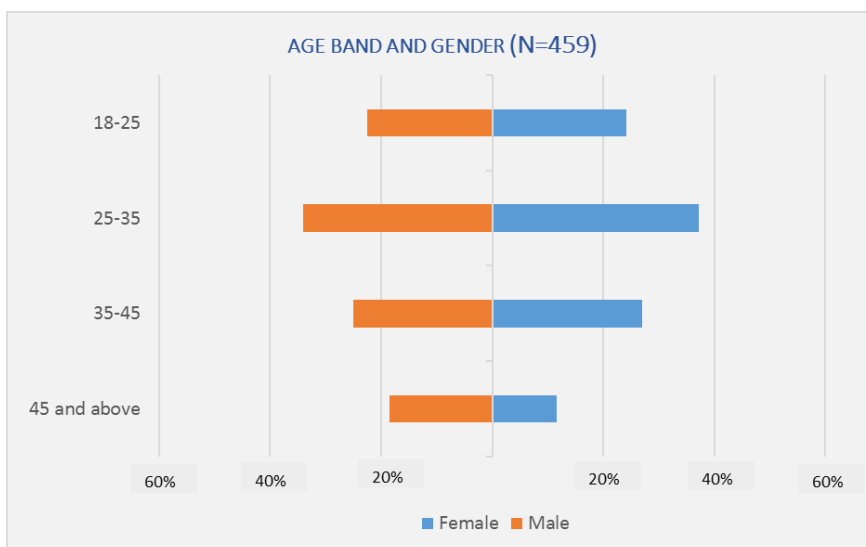
From 1 April to 30 June 2019



Iraq and Syria represent half of the reported country of birth of RESP clients in the most recent quarter, with 17% of clients born in Fiji

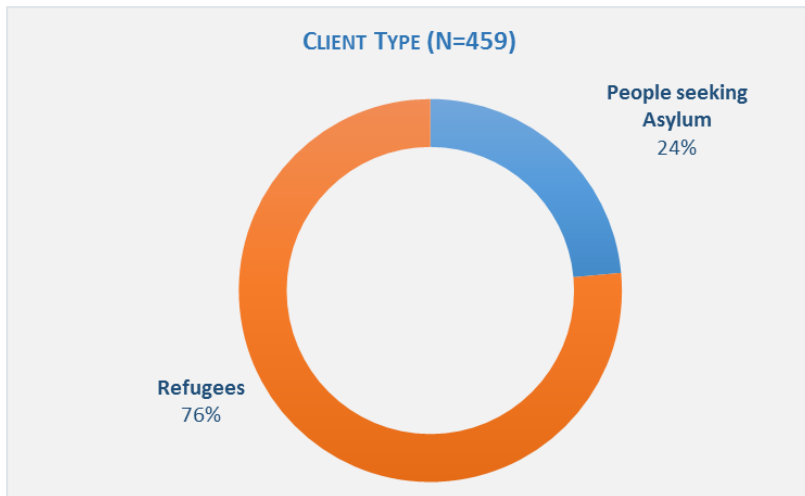


In the most recent quarter there is an even distribution of reported ethnicity among Fijian, Syrian and Iraqi

*The RESP is only open to clients aged 18-55

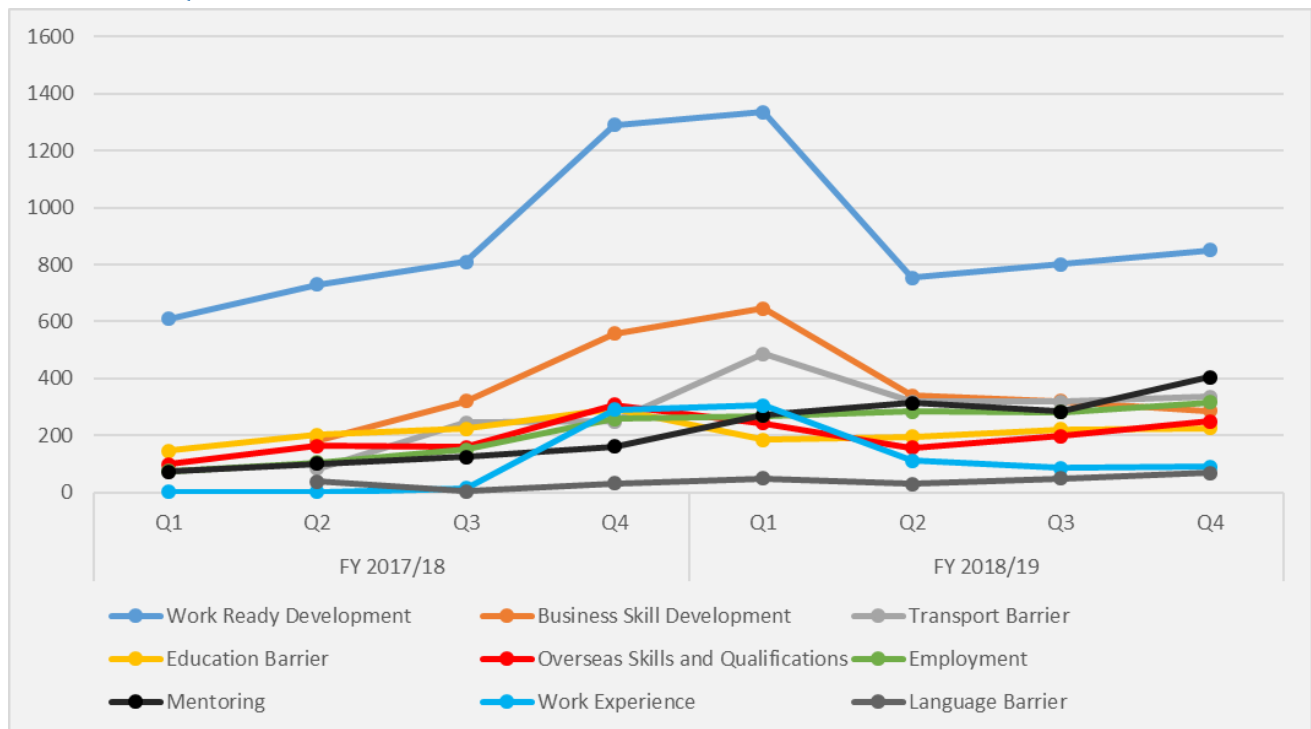


In the most recent quarter, about two-thirds of RESP clients are refugees, and one third are people seeking asylum

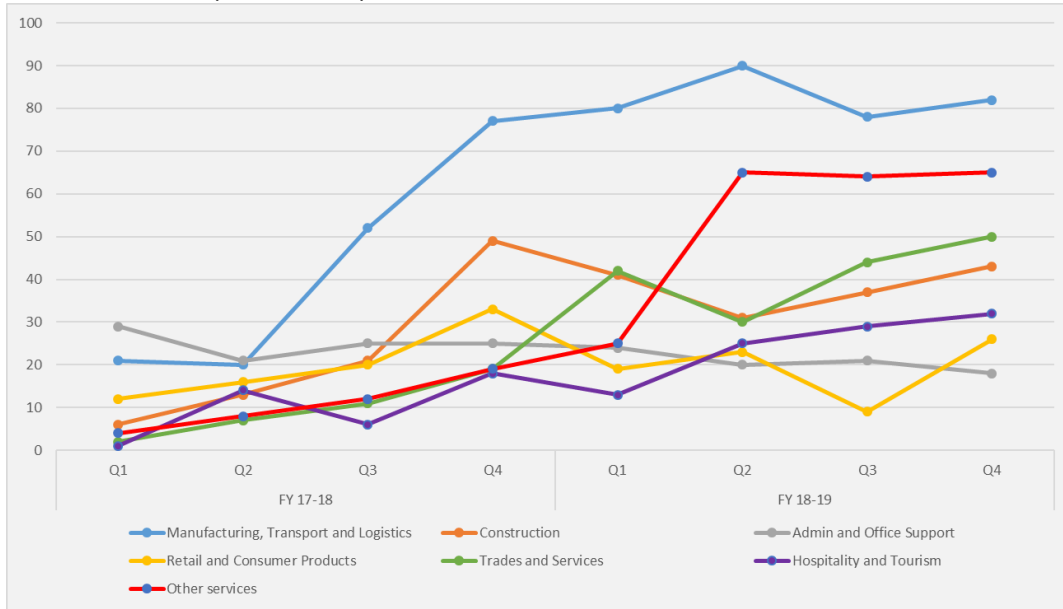
OUTCOMES BY QUARTER



Work Ready Development and Mentoring are trending upwards in the most recent quarter

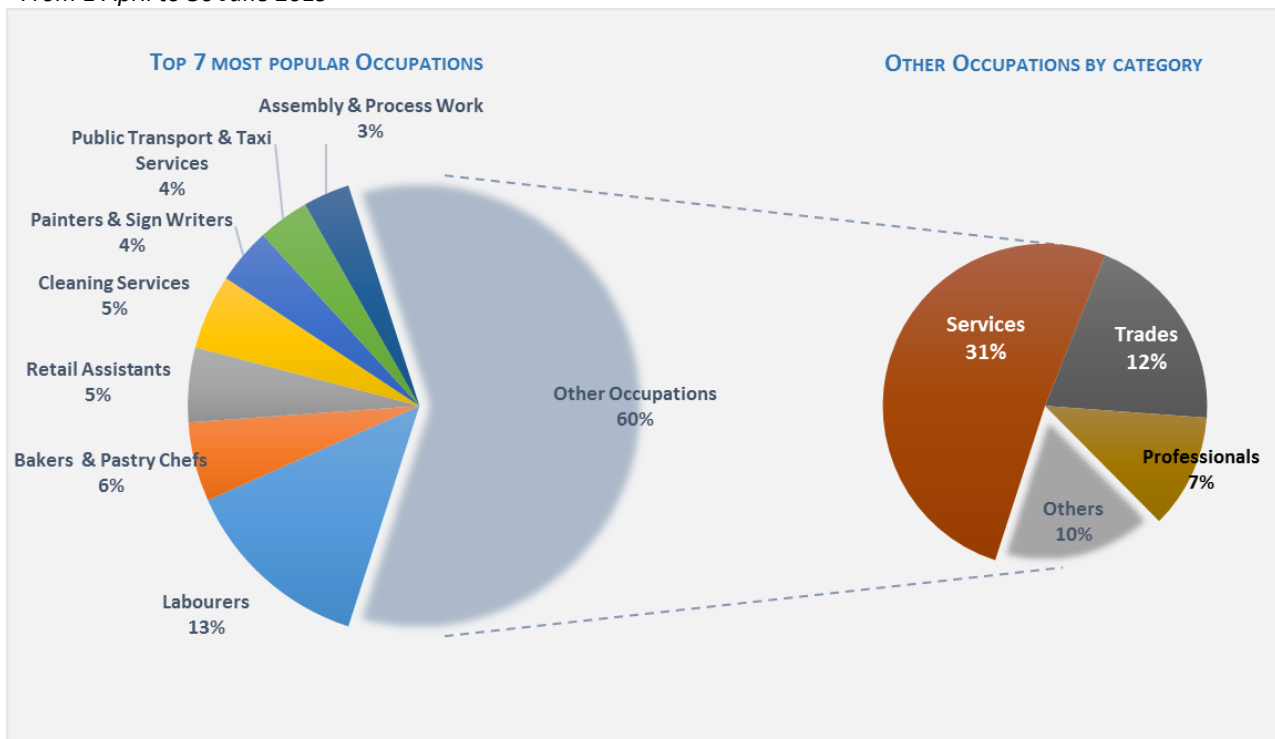

In the most recent quarter most of the industry sectors are trending upwards apart from Admin and Office Support

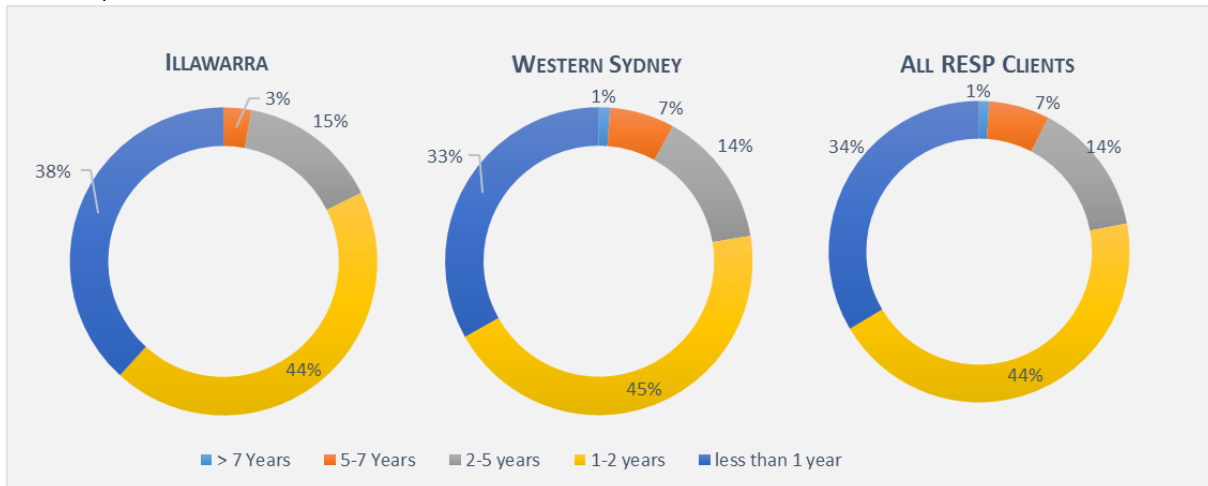
TOP 5 MOST POPULAR OCCUPATIONS AND OTHER OCCUPATIONS BY CATEGORY
