

**SSI Allianz RefugeeScholarships**  
2021 academic year / **Secondary School**



## Scholarship Information

The SSI Allianz Refugee Scholarships have been created to minimise the financial barriers experienced by refugees as they participate in the NSW education system.

The secondary school scholarships reflect an understanding that many students from a refugee background can experience unique challenges at this stage of their education. Often older children within the family can be expected to contribute to the overall family income. The scholarship is an acknowledgement that many students, and their families, cannot afford extra-curricular activities, such as sport, music and arts that contribute to a well-rounded education.

The eligibility criteria for these scholarships is aimed at selecting students who are most in need of support, in relation to school fees, study materials and uniforms, in order to complete their high school education.

Scholarships of up to \$1,500 each are available for eligible students of a refugee background to study in NSW.

### Eligibility Criteria:

To be successful in their application for support, students must:

- be from a refugee background on a humanitarian visa - Subclass 200, 201, 202, 203 or 204
- have been living in Australia for five years or less
- be able to demonstrate additional socio-economic disadvantage such as financial hardship or family challenges
- be enrolled in years 7–12 in 2021 at a NSW public or independent school
- reside in NSW
- not have been awarded an SSI scholarship previously

N.B. if successful no more than one scholarship will be granted per immediate family

### Scholarship Purpose:

The scholarship funding is intended to support students in their academic pursuits and can be used by the student or their family to contribute towards items such as:

- school fees
- extra tuition costs
- uniforms
- transport
- textbooks and relevant course materials
- technology costs, such as computer, software and internet access

### Application Guidelines:

Applications can be made by the student and/or their family, or alternatively on behalf of the student by an authorised school representative such as a principal, teacher or teacher's aide.

Applicants must:

- complete the application form in full in the applicant's own words
- provide a letter of introduction
- be able to satisfy the visa eligibility requirements
- be able to provide evidence supporting their application if deemed necessary

### 5. Terms and Conditions

- SSI reserves the right to seek additional verification of applicants' submissions.
- Where a student either intends to change the circumstances of their study or experiences a change to their circumstances of study, as listed below, they must inform SSI in writing at the earliest possible opportunity.
  - The SSI Committee will then determine on a case-by-case basis whether the scholarship will be cancelled and the recipient is required to return their scholarship funding, either in part or in full.
  - A 'change of circumstances' includes:
    - deferring studies
    - changing the course of study
    - changing the institution of study
    - incompleting of the course of study
    - unsuccessful application to study
    - unsatisfactory academic progress
    - ceasing to meet the eligibility requirements of the scholarship
    - failing to return to study after an approved interruption to their scholarship purpose

- SSI reserves the right to cancel any scholarship and ask the recipient to return their scholarship funding, either in part or in full should:
  - the recipient, or their agent, be found to have provided false or misleading information during or subsequent to the application process,
  - the recipient commit serious misconduct at their educational institution (serious misconduct may be determined by either the institution or SSI)
- Recipients agree to the periodic assessment of their chosen study/course as covered by the scholarship. This is to ensure that the recipient remains eligible for the scholarship throughout their relevant study period.
