Purpose:

Employment mentors will support SSI Employment Services to guide recently arrived refugees who are seeking employment in areas that are the same or similar to each mentor's own professional background.

Volunteers add significant value to refugees' job seeking efforts by offering insight into industry job markets, targeted job application strategies and workplace culture. Where appropriate, mentors will also look to introduce job seekers to their own professional networks and contacts. By engaging with job seekers on a one-on-one basis employment mentors will assist refugees to develop specific skills, knowledge and confidence to gain employment in the industry of their choice.

Specific duties and responsibilities:

- Support participants to achieve their employment goals by developing strategies to pursue employment in their chosen profession
- Provide guidance and support in relation to Australian work life, rights and culture in participants' industry of choice
- Provide information about professional and educational requirements for specific professions
- Support participants to develop industry specific language and communication skills
- Connect participants to industry contacts
- Maintain regular contact with participants and the Employment Integration Coordinator
- Actively support SSI's vision and values
- Work in accordance with SSI policies and procedures
- Follow all reasonable directions provided by the Employment Integration Coordinator or delegate
