Purpose:

The Humanitarian Settlement Program (HSP) assists newly arrived refugees to develop the skills and knowledge they need to become self-reliant, independent and active members of our community. The Specialised and Intensive Services (SIS) team provides intensive support to eligible refugee and asylum seeker clients with complex and exceptional needs.

Specialised Community Support Assistants will provide assistance to SIS clients in attending their medical appointments, community engagement activities and events. Volunteers will also offer language support, assist with phone calls to clients and assist with basic admin tasks.

Specific duties and responsibilities:

- Call clients regarding appointments and to provide basic information
- Provide language support to clients as and when required, including explaining letters and mail received by clients
- Support clients to develop the skills to independently access various services including health, education, legal and family support and to develop understanding of life in Australia
- Support clients to access public transport to attend appointments
- Where required, transport clients to appointments by car
- Assist clients to attend community engagement events and activities
- Actively support SSI's vision and values
