The SSI Welcome Program pairs newcomers with established locals to explore iconic landmarks and scenic spots to make Australia feel like home and increase a sense of community. The program builds a sense of belonging and connection through the cross-cultural exchange of newcomers, locals and volunteers.

Meet Mohsen

Despite having a bachelor's degree in biomedical engineering and experience in the banking sector, Iranian-born Mohsen faced employment challenges in both fields after finding safety in Australia following three year's detention on Christmas Island. Mohsen's first priority was getting a job, but while highly qualified he struggled to find employment due to his limited English language proficiency, visa status and lack of local networks.

"I applied for so many jobs all over Sydney, but no one would give me a chance," he said.



With support from the SSI's Refugee Employment Support Program (RESP), Mohsen participated in work readiness workshops, gained insights into the local job market, established networks, connected with mentors and empowered to thrive in the Australian workforce. Mohsen then went on to enrol and complete a Bachelor of Business, landed a job with ANZ bank and today has found independence and security through establishing his own business as an independent mortgage broker.

"I can say that with SSI you do not feel you are alone ... You can achieve your dreams and work with people who share a similar journey and background."
