For young fathers from multicultural communities



This one-year program brings together young men in fatherhood or caregiving roles to connect, reflect, and learn together.

Through genuine conversations, participants will:

- Learn about parenting
- Meet other men with shared experiences
- Work together on creative ideas to share positive messages about fatherhood with other dads in the community

What to expect

- Monthly face-to-face group sessions (one-year commitment)
- Sessions co-designed with you
- Safe, interactive and supportive peer environment
- Reimbursement for your time, input and contribution

The program is for young men who are:

- Fathers, expecting a child, or stepping into a caregiving role
- From migrant or refugee backgrounds
- Aged 18-35
- In Logan and South Brisbane region (flexible)
- Interested in supporting other young dads in their community
